Based on the document mentioned hereunder, one may expect limited opportunities on telecommunications related issues. <p><b>COST</b>  The European Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST) is an organization for the creation of research networks, called COST Actions. These networks offer an open space for collaboration among scientists across Europe (and beyond) and thereby give impetus to research advancements and innovation.</p> <p>Proposals for a COST Action must represent a network composed of proposers from at least seven (7) COST Members amongst which a minimum number shall be from COST Inclusiveness Target Countries.( Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Republic of North Macedonia, Republic of Serbia and Turkey).</p> <p>Selected proposals for COST Actions will get a financial support in the range of EUR 134.000 p.a., normally for four years, subject to available budget.</p> <p>Proposers benefit from a one-stage submission via the <a href="#">e-COST submission tool</a>.
